At our quarterly business meeting on June 7, the church voted to accept the recommendation of the Organ Committee to enter into a contract with Austin Organs, Inc., of Hartford, CT, for a pipe organ for our sanctuary. The recommendation was the result of a considerable amount of prayer, investigation, and discussion on the part of the Organ Committee--over a period of several years. The instrument will have 22 ranks of pipes (1,342 in all!) which will be installed in our present organ chambers (behind the grille work on each side of the front of the sanctuary).

The cost of the organ will be approximately \$300,000, plus the necessary architectural and electrical preparation of the chambers, which is estimated at approx. \$75,000. At last count the organ fund had balance of approximately \$312,000; two church members have already promised to contribute an additional \$45,000.

The organ has been designed specifically for our sanctuary, and now must be built to those specifications. We anticipate installation in 15 to 18 months (Fall, 2010). This will surely be a cause for celebration.
